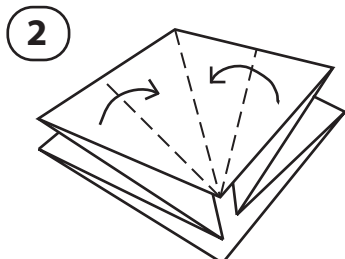
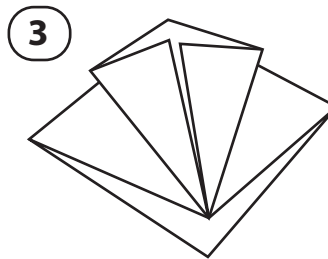


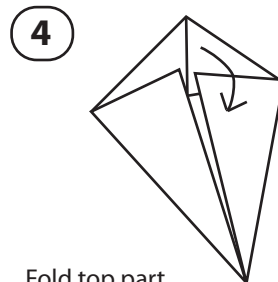
1 Fold where shown, then bring corners together to form the next shape.



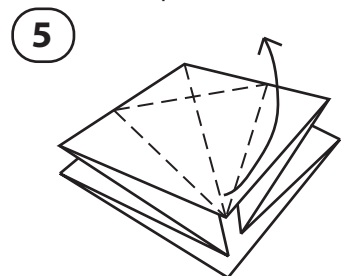
2 Fold sides to meet the middle.



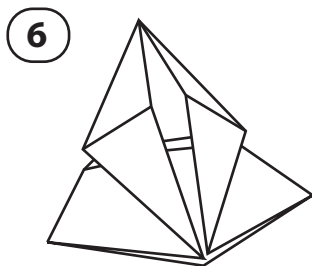
3 Turn over and repeat on other side.



4 Fold top part over and back to make crease.



5 Flatten out, then pull bottom to the top.



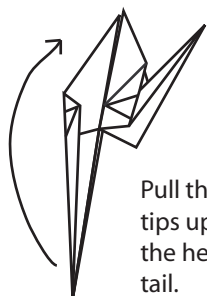
6 Turn over and repeat on other side.



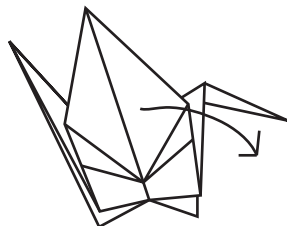
Fold sides to meet the middle.



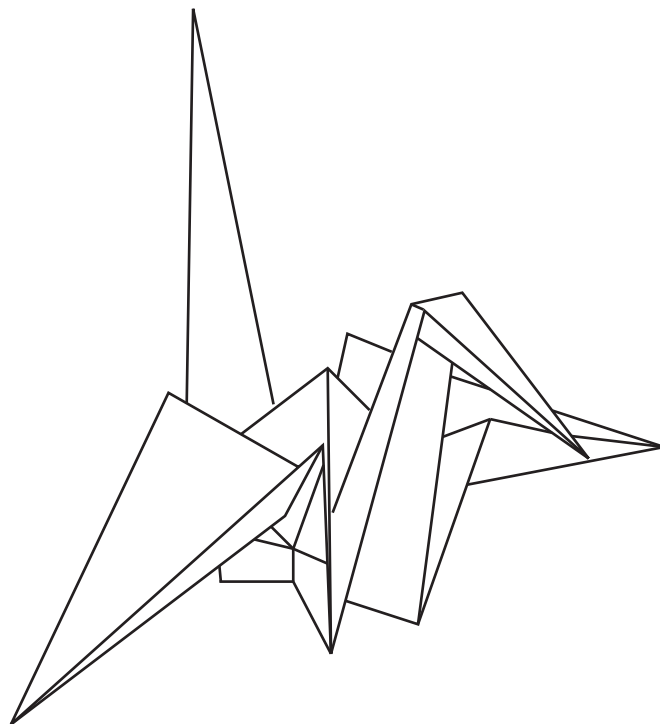
Turn over and repeat on other side.



Pull the bottom tips up to form the head and tail.



Now fold the wings down.

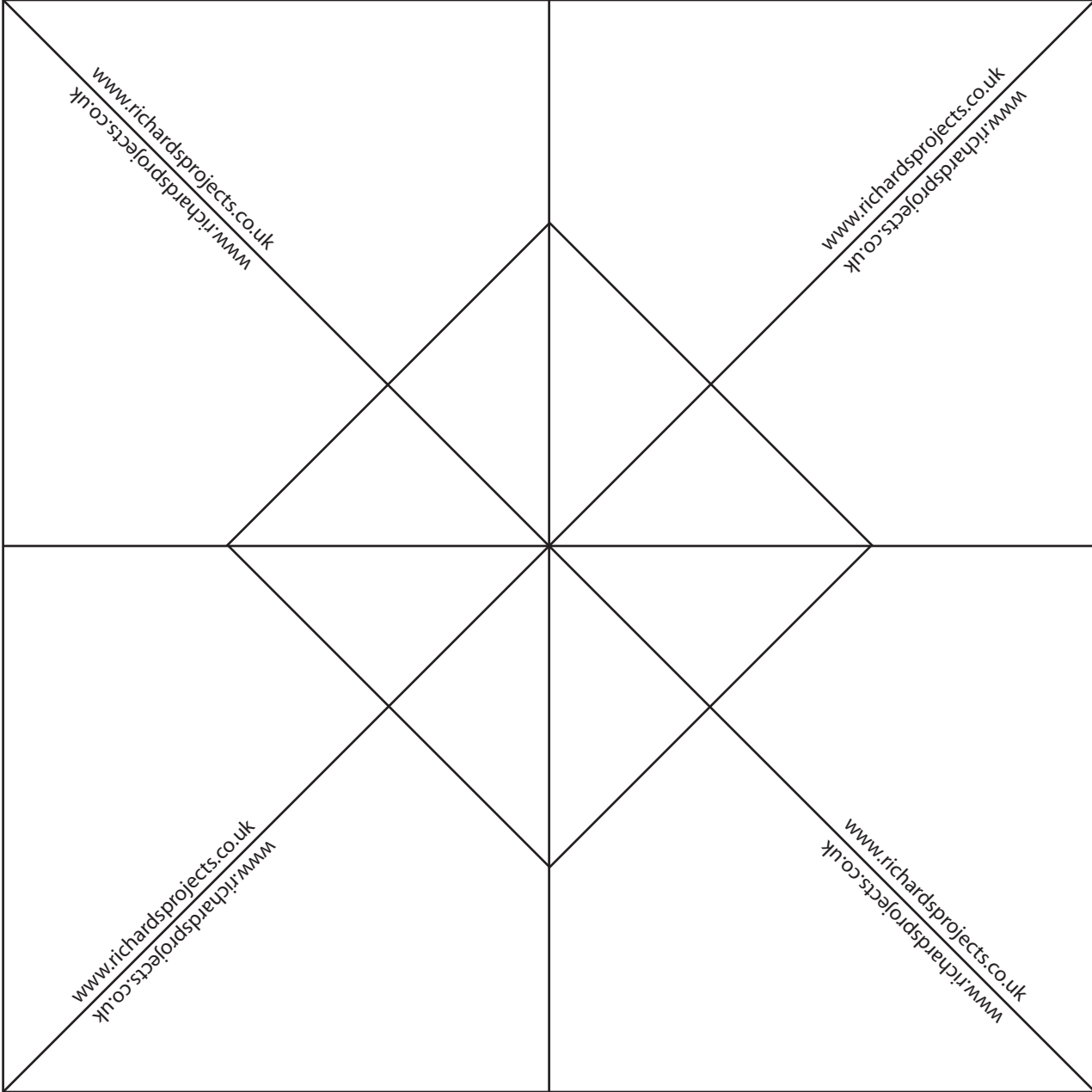


You can now while away the hours making paper cranes.
